

1. Go to get the Hogwarts Express! But don't go to Platform 9¾, or any platform, but find the bridge that the Knight Bus won't fit under. How tall is the tallest vehicle that will fit underneath?
2. Go under the bridge, and keep going until you find the Oxford Local Board taking credit where credit's due. Turn left straight away, and walk until you find a lock that *Alohomora* won't work on. You'll find three signs about drenching Mr Weasley's actor; what's the year of the oldest?
3. Keep walking along the river, past the obelisk. On the railway bridge you'll find a member of Binky's species holding a sign: what does it say?
4. Straight under the bridge, take the right fork, then the left. Keep going until there's a bridge, and cross it. You have two options on the other side: take the left. You'll find a lamppost with a magical number stencilled on it. What letters come before it?
5. Follow the water wheel. At the road, turn right. After not very long, you'll pass a street sign with Alexander Homer <alexander.homer@wolfson.ox.ac.uk> a word on it that you might find on the scar on Dumbledore's knee. What's the word?
6. Follow Speedwell Street. You'll find a university department devoted to a magic beyond all they do at Hogwarts. Next to it is a sign. What number should you enter to explore more?
7. Walk towards the Hogwarts Entrance Hall college, but walk past it (Tom Tower entrance). Eventually you'll find a sign: who was the bride who got married on 6th July 1893?
8. There's a Ravenclaw-coloured mammal that has a street; follow it, and turn left opposite the Ravenclaw door on the right. You want to go straight across this road, but take the crossing to be safe! There's a shop with Dumbledore in the window, and opposite a box for something that doesn't go today, so you'll have to use an owl—or wait until when tomorrow?
9. Might Ginny make metal bogeys come out of this Lane? Take it, and keep going until Crookshanks' Street, then turn left. Just before the crossroads, the building on the right used to be what, according to the inscription above the door?
10. Go to the home of the dragons (alright, the dinosaurs). Find the barn owl (location clue: owls can fly). Below it is a bird that Hermione is in the first book, in a way; what is it?
11. Now go into the museum at the back (it has a case of heads like Ernie's). Find the case containing musical instruments of the same kind Hagrid gave Harry. You'll find one shaped like a frog: which continent is it from? (For this clue there is a five-minute penalty for incorrect answers.)
12. You've just visited two Ms; go back out through them, and take M Road, going towards another M. That M has a gallery containing Galleons, Sickles and Knuts: actual treasure! Which bank issued the highest-denomination note?

That's all the clues. Go to the Swan and Castle to record your time.
